

Number of Students Taking SAT, AP and PSAT-Related Assessments



2013 thru 2017




Highlights

- This graph shows 5 years of data at the school, state and global level
- Reflects the year over year changes in the % of AP students with a score of 3 or higher
- Success on an AP exam is defined as an exam score of 3 or higher
 - ✓ Research shows that a score point of 3 or higher is predictive of college success and college graduation
 - ✓ These findings have held consistent across the decades
 - ✓ This score is also a strong predictor of a student's ability to persist in college and earn a bachelor's degree

- West Milford students outperformed students on the state and global level for the past 3 years
- The best results were achieved in 2016
- Test result have improved since 2013 and 2014
- Class size decreased from 2016 to 2017 by
 7.5% which could impact AP participation


SAT® College and Career Readiness Benchmarks

- Overall college and career readiness is defined as achieving both of the section-level benchmarks on a given assessment.



PSAT NMSQT Benchmark for 11th Grade











- All students test in the am at the same time
- Scores are released mid-December
- Free Personalized SAT ® practice on Khan Academy based on a students' strengths and weaknesses
- Colleges will not be able to see PSAT scores or use it as a basis for admission
- Access to online college and career planning tools
- Admission and financial aid information from colleges
- Majors and career exploration with College Board and Road Trip Nation
- Juniors eligible for consideration for the scholarships awarded by the National Merit Corporation.
- Certain score may be used for students in the class of 2018-20 to demonstrate proficiency and meet
 New Jersey State Department of Education Graduation Assessment Requirements, provided students
 in class of 2020 take all available PARCC assessments

Prior to Assessment:

- Parent outreach to inform and educate
- Distribution of PSAT details
- Catalyst Test Prep Boot Camp offered at WMHS the weekend just prior to the WMHS administratins of the SAT and ACT in the Spring and Fall (fee based)

After the Assessment:

- January:In-class program to deliver score reports and test booklet
- Release of unused PSAT books made available to staf for integrationinto the curriculum
- February: Parent Evening Presentation: Understanding the Score Report
- Score interpretation
- Demonstration to pull scores into existing College Board account or creation of a new one
- Demonstration of test preparation, college and career tools provided by College Board
- Demonstration of syncing score report with Khan Academy to provide free, customized test prep program to support PSAT 10, NMSQT and SAT
- Demonstration of PSAT scores and scattergrams found in Naviance/Family Connection to help identify trends in college admissions
