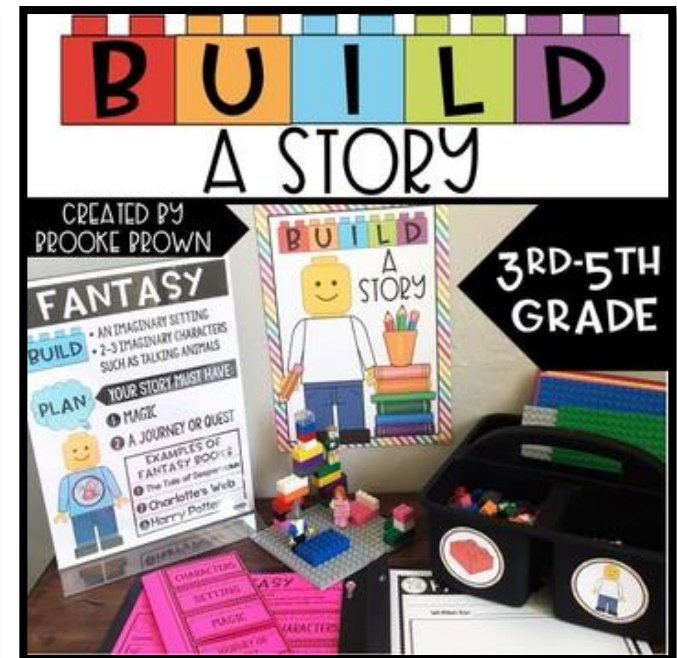
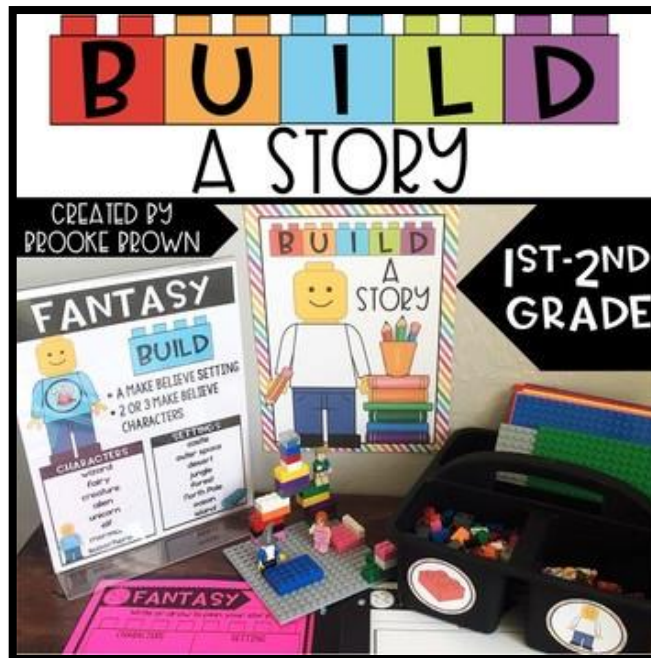
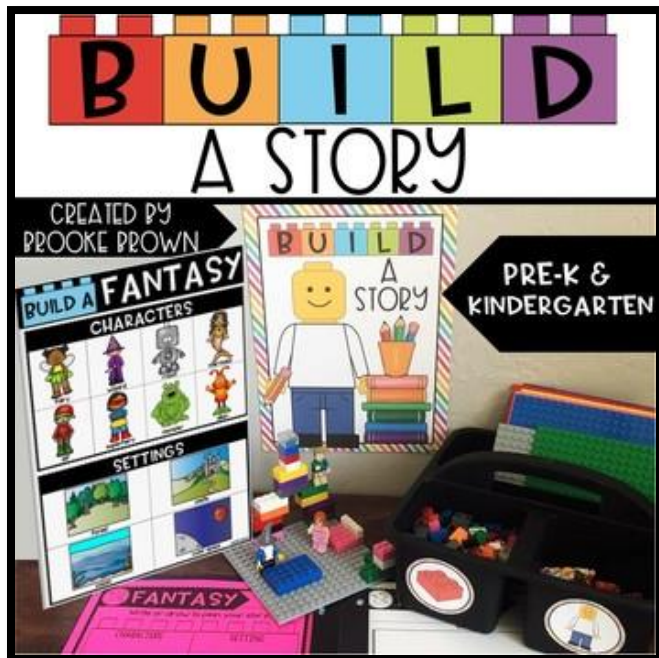


# BUILD A STORY
