Welcome to Unit 4 of the MUZZY Spanish Complete Elementary Program. In Unit 4 your child learns to name 22 foods and drinks in Spanish. He or she also learns to classify foods by sorting them into categories such as Fruits, Vegetables, Meats, Dairy, Cereals and Grains, and Fats/Sugars. We work with the food pyramid and understand how these food groupings are important in our daily lives.

The following section is an overview of the vocabulary words and phrases covered in Unit 4. You may wish to practice or review these words with your child.
